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Alternative Learning Purpose: To provide an appropriate balance of digital and tangible learning opportunities for students to continue learning when face-to-face instruction is not possible. Below are recommended resources sorted by grade level and content that teachers may use to create learning opportunities for students. Elementary: If possible, K-5 students could engage in DreamBox for 30 minutes daily, typing.com for 20 minutes daily and either read to self or others for 30 minutes.
